Senior: an individual age 55 and over.

Student: an individual who is enrolled for nine or more credits. Submit a copy of your current student ID and proof of student status (e.g. course schedule) must be submitted with payment and the completed conference registration form.

Activist: an individual who is employed by, or volunteers for a nonprofit organization. Individuals must supply a brief letter on their organization's letterhead, signed by a representative of the organization. The letter should describe your work and how your participation in the conference will benefit your community.
